This course is an opportunity for students to learn about Murshidabad's history in the 18th century and how we see this history today.

Course 1 introduces students to different ways of reading historical sources. It provides them with the tools and space to reflect on the representational character of history. We want you to discover how historical figures respond to specific situations they encounter and to each other; how they created meaning in the past and how we can connect this history to today. Particularly in Course 2, we will look at different physical forms in which history is preserved, narrated and displayed by different actors. You will be able to speak to curators and learn from historians and artists how they see history.
