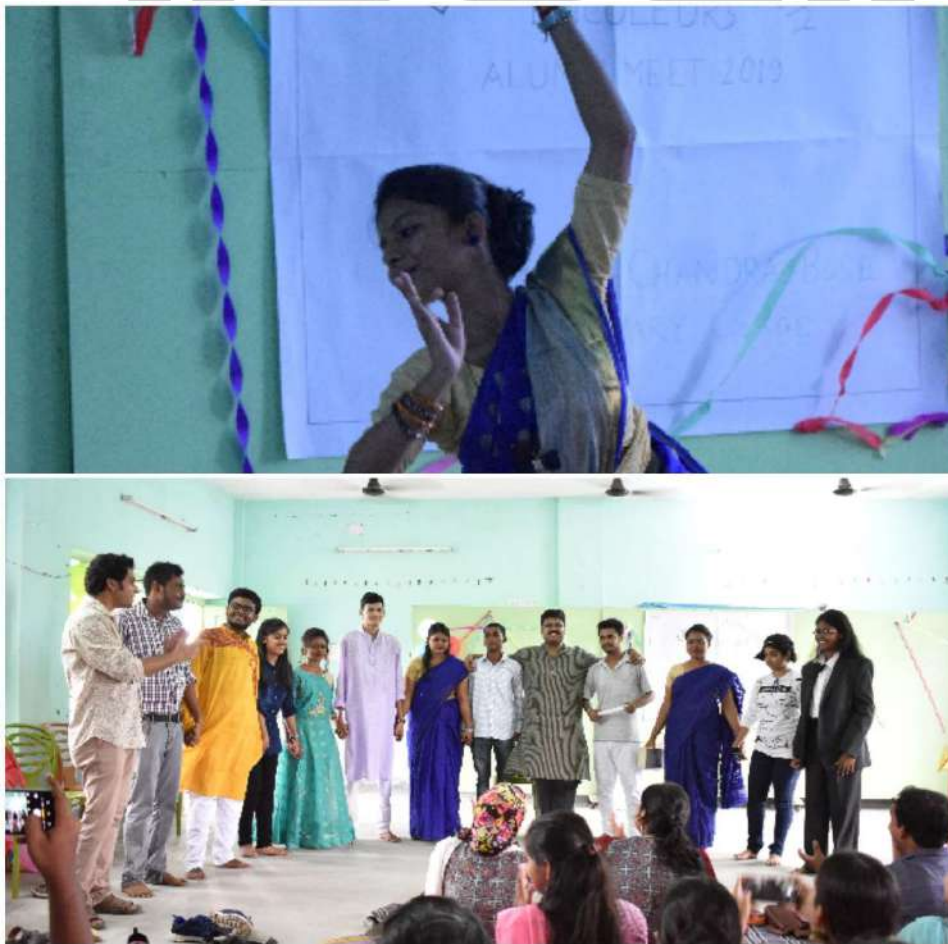


ANNUAL ALUMNI MEET FOR THE SESSION 2019-2020
